- Survey made the students sensible and sensitive.

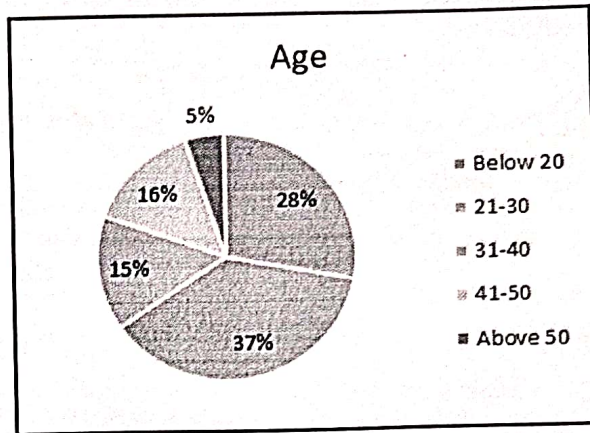

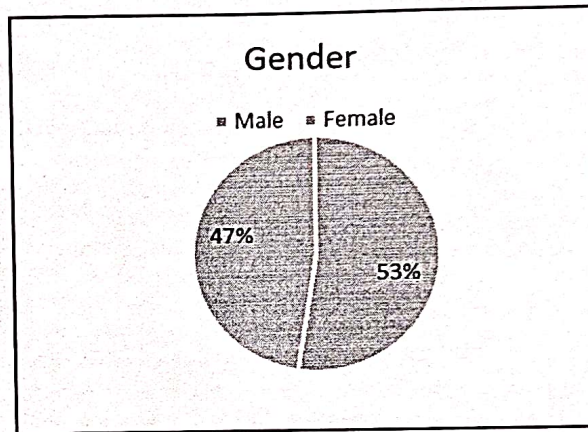

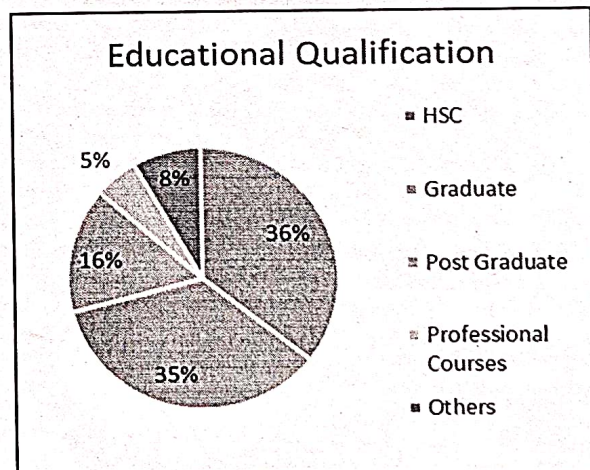

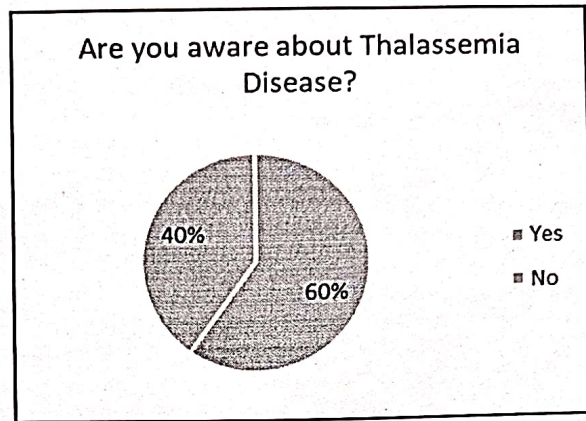




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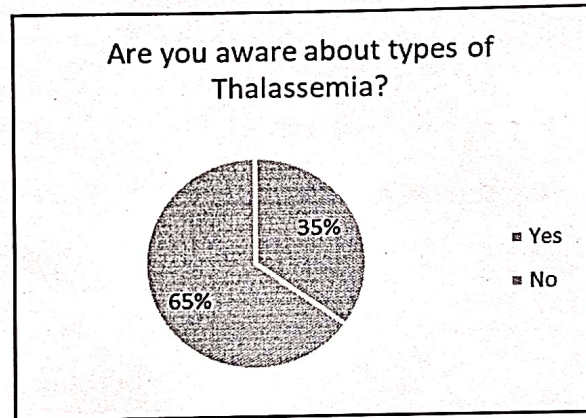
**4. Are you aware about Thalassemia Disease?**

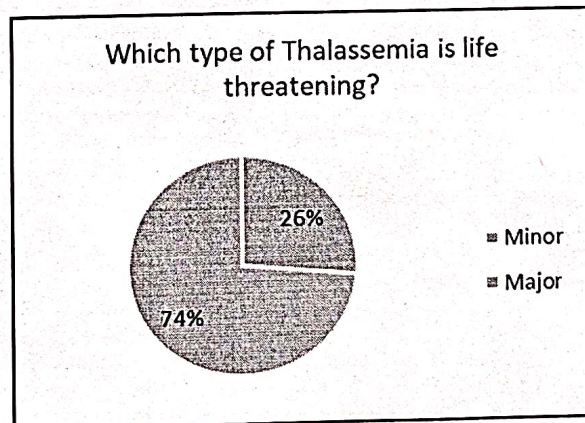
**5. Are you aware about types of Thalassemia?**

**6. Which type of Thalassemia is life threatening?**

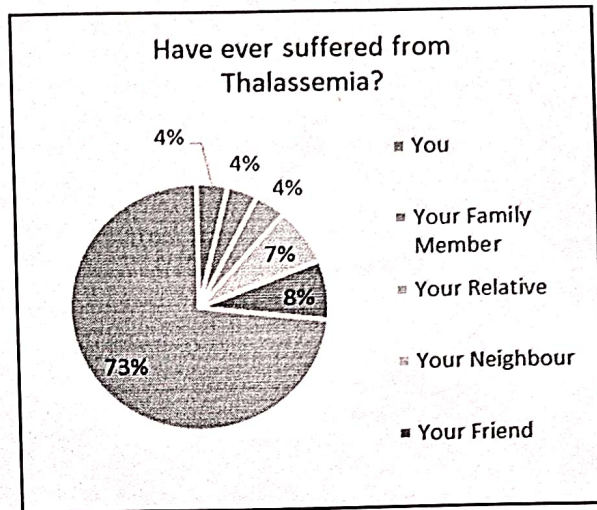

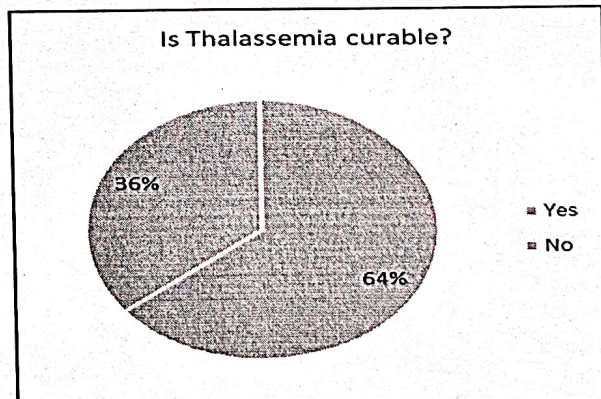
